LAST WILL & TESTAMENT

REVOCABLE LIVING TRUST

GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

HEALTHCARE SURROGATE

Document designating a surrogate for health care decisions in the event you become incapacitated and are unable to provide informed consent for medical treatment.

LIVING WILL

Willfully and voluntarily make known your health-care desire in the event you are incapacitated and are in persistent vegetative state.
